Often asked questions

Q. What is Kiwanis?

A. Kiwanis is a worldwide service organization of men and women who want to improve their communities. It was founded in 1915. It is currently headquartered in Indianapolis, IN.

Q. What is the origin of the name "Kiwanis"?

A. The name Kiwanis was coined from an Ojibwe American Indian expression that has several meanings: we build; we share our talents; we meet.

Q. Where are Hudson Kiwanis meetings held?

A. Most meetings are held at the Hudson Library. Occasionally other locations are used.

Q. When are meetings held?

A. We meet twice/month. Summer meetings are once/month. Attendance at monthly board meetings is optional.

Q. Are there attendance requirements?

A. The attendance goal is 75% of regular meetings.

Q. What are the meeting times?

A. Mondays from 6:30 to 8:00 PM

Q. Who can join?

A. Individuals of good standing in the community...invited by Kiwanis. The investment of time and the dues is small compared to the tremendous satisfaction that Kiwanis membership provides.
